Dr. Sahores published "Repertorio Bibliográfico Argentino de 1833 a 1970" (Argentine bibliographic repertory from 1833 to 1970), 1977, FECIC; "Epónimos en Ortopedia y Traumatología" (Eponyms in Traumatology and Orthopedics), 2007, EUS, for which he was awarded the Premio Bienal de la Sociedad Argentina de Historia de la Medicina; "Historia de la Ortopedia Argentina" (Argentine Orthopedics History), 2011, Editorial Dunken; "Apoyo de Sanidad de los argentinos a los franceses en la Primera Guerra" (Argentina's health assistance to France during the First World War), 2017, EAB.

He was the recipient of several awards: the biennial medical search award "José María Ramos Mejía", the Qualitas Award for Orthopedics and Traumatology evidence-based surgical training, Master Surgeon Award from the Argentine Association of Orthopedics and Traumatology, and on two occasions the "Florencio Fiorini" award.


